3.0 Declaration

I/we understand that AEI will:

- Visit the home of the Designated Caregiver prior to the enrolment, if possible, to determine that the living conditions are of an acceptable standard
- Assess whether the Designated Caregiver will provide a safe physical and emotional environment for the student
- Determine that the accommodation is not a boarding establishment (i.e. does not have 5 or more international students staying in the home)
- Meet with the Designated Caregiver/s and establish communication with the Designated Caregiver.
- Meet the student at least quarterly to ensure the accommodation is suitable
- Require a NZ Police vet to be undertaken

Should this arrangement change I/we undertake to inform AEI immediately. Further, I/we understand that should AEI have any concerns regarding the welfare of my/our child while studying in their school they will advise me/us immediately or, if necessary, refer the matter to the relevant child welfare authorities, or any other appropriate agency in New Zealand.

I/we confirm that the person/s nominated as the designated caregiver's is/are a 'bona fide' relative or close family friend. (Proof of this relationship may be required).
